

TITLE:Level I MechanicREPORTS TO:Director of TransportationQUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Mechanical training and skills required to perform basic school bus maintenance
- 2. A valid commercial driver's license with all appropriate endorsements and classifications and all other required licenses, permits and certificates.
- 3. The ability to successfully complete a criminal history background check and provide proof of U.S. citizenship or legal resident alien status.
- 4. Current residency in New Jersey, approved residency waiver or agreement to obtain residency within one year of employment.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Level I Mechanic will function as a mechanic, assistant to the Level II Mechanic and as a substitute bus driver and gas attendant.

## ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Takes full responsibility for securing, operating, and maintaining the gasoline pump(s), tanks, and gasoline supplies on a daily basis.
- 2. Fills fuel tanks of school buses at district owned gasoline pumps daily.
- 3. Examines and maintain appropriate levels of motor oil, brake fluid, radiator water, etc. on a scheduled basis.
- 4. Conducts daily visual examination of each bus while at the gas pump for safety, equipment or operational hazards or malfunctions. Corrects, records and reports such finding immediately.
- 5. Examines and measures school bus tire wear, tread performance on a scheduled basis. Implements the district's standards for replacement and conducts replacements with the approval of the Director of Transportation.
- 6. Transports vehicles, parts, supplies, etc., as directed by the Level II Mechanic or Director of Transportation.
- 7. Assists the Level II Mechanic and office personnel in scheduling and preparing drivers and buses for state inspection.
- 8. Maintains the cleanliness and appearance of bus exteriors on an ongoing basis and conducts interior cleaning as directed by the Director of Transportation.
- 9. Assists and works cooperatively with the Level II Mechanic as required and fills in for the Level II Mechanic to the degree possible during periods of absence.
- 10. Assumes the full responsibility and duties of a substitutes school bus driver as directed by the Director of Transportation.
- 11. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as assigned by the Director of Transportation.
